

# **Minutes of Special meeting of Abthorpe Parish Council on Friday 21st December 2018 at 4.30pm at 5 Snelson's Orchard, Abthorpe.**

**1. To receive and approve apologies for absence**

A declaration of interest was raised from Councillor Cambray as an adjoining landowner.

**3. Specific items for discussion**

**1. Planning consultation/Information for application reference S/2018/2727/AGD at Brackley Lane Abthorpe NN12 8QJ**

It appears that the building is for agricultural purposes. It is proposed to be used as a large enclosed hay/fodder store. It was noted that the applicant raises a herd of livestock on this site and adjacent.

The members agreed unanimously that as an agricultural building for agricultural use within an agricultural setting they had no objection to it.

**2. Planning consultation/Information for application reference S/2018/2698/FUL at Yew Tree House 8 The Green Abthorpe NN12 8QP**

This will be discussed at the meeting on 7th January 2019 at 7.45pm as an extension has been granted.

**4. Any other business**

Councillor Cambray reported an ongoing problem caused by parking on Wappenham Road leading to some residents being obstructed from free use of their own access and garage. A matter for the highway authority, the Council nonetheless acknowledged that the volume of residents vehicles creates congestion in some areas of the village and agreed to request Abtalk to place a reminder article about this issue in the next edition.
